## Cornish Rock X Chicks



The Cornish x White Rock is the standard bird of the commercial poultry industry. The males of this cross can reach around 4.5 pounds by 6 weeks and 9.5 pounds by 11 weeks, on average. There are faster growing strains. The females grow a bit slower; at about 2.5 pounds (5 weeks) they are marketed as Cornish Game Hens.

\*Capons are neutered cockerels that grow to be approximately 8-10 lbs. by 9 weeks of age. The benefits are a non-aggressive male that can serve as a mother for baby chicks. They also produce ample, tender meat when butchered and as such are a choice poultry meat. Due to the high fat content, they are self-basting.

Our farm has produced birds up to 12 pounds dressed, and customers have reported a 12 pound average in bird size.

## MT-DI Red Broiler

This colored broiler features excellent breast meat yields, superb feed conversion, strong disease resistance, increased livability, strong legs and a more aggressive nature suitable for its organic, free-range environment.

This broiler is a very profitable broiler to raise because of its strong disease resistance. It has an excellent conformation of white and dark meat yields, a tender texture with the flavor of a slow growing bird. It has a dark red feathering with a few of the tail feathers being either white or black, yellow shanks, beak, and skin. The Red Broiler is from French origin and will reach 3.74 lbs. at 42 days, 4.52 obs. At 49 days, 5.25 lbs. at 56 days, 5.94 lbs. at 63 days on a 3200 k/cal diet.

## Rosambro Broiler

This broiler has been bred for robust health and wellbeing, ideally suited to free range and organic systems as well as less intensive indoor production. This enables the broiler to exhibit excellent livability. The Rosambro is feather sexable allowing the male and female broilers to be grown separately if needed. The broilers are adaptable to different types of diet and have an advantage in feed efficiency. ## 17-week old Sex-Link Pullets

(Shown at 8 weeks)



Red Sex-Links are the result of various crosses. White Rocks with the silver factor (the dominant white gene would produce all white offspring) are crossed with a New Hampshire male to produce the Golden Comet. Silver Laced Wyandotte crossed with New Hampshire gives the Cinnamon Queen. Two other crosses are obtained with Rhode Island White x Rhode Island Red, and Delaware x Production Red. These two crosses are simply called Red Sex-Links. Males hatch out white and, depending on the cross, feather out to pure white or with some black feathering. Females hatch out buff or red also depending on cross, and they feather out in one of three ways.

## Multi Color Sex-Link Chicks



Red Sex-links are amazing layers of extra large eggs. These birds were bred to be sexed at birth. The parents are a Rhode Island Red rooster and a White Rock hen. The resulting offspring are Red Sex-links. These birds are sexed at birth by color. The male chicks are yellow while a female will be a reddish color.

### Broad Breasted Turkey - Hybrid B-6

These large white birds are the most popular for the commercial market, as the carcass shows no pin feathers. They are referred to as Broad-breasted Whites in commercial terminology. Like the Broad-breasted Bronze turkeys, the Broad-breasted Whites are usually unable to mate naturally, requiring artificial insemination.
